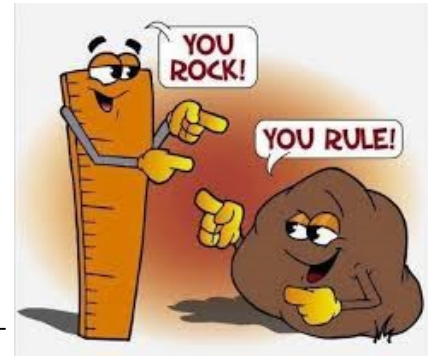

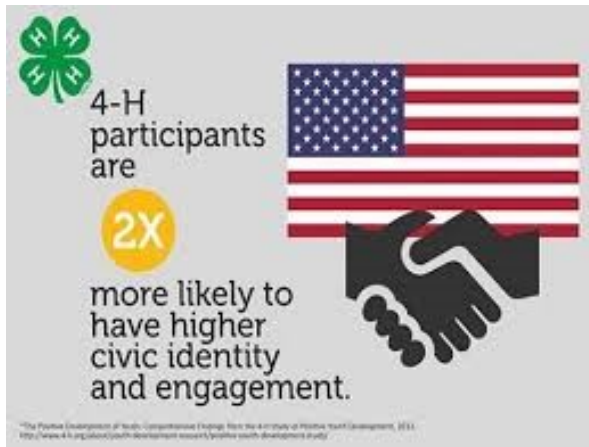
It's Record Book Time!
